SPORTS/SPIRIT LEADER CONTRACT

Saint Anne Catholic School Athletic Program is dedicated to the physical and Christian development of the students. We stress that students must put forth their best efforts in order to participate in sports and spirit leader activities.

Students must:

1. Students participating in sports and/or spirit leading are required to have no grade lower than a 70% in more than one subject and no unsatisfactory grades in effort, conduct, or homework. If more than one academic grade falls below a 70% at any time, the student will be suspended from the sport or spirit leading until the aforementioned criteria is met. **The student will be ineligible for a minimum of five (5) school days beginning the day after the parent is notified. If the effort, conduct or homework grade is noted as unsatisfactory, the same rule applies.**
2. Put forth 100% effort at practices.
3. Attend practices unless excused by a written note from parents.
4. No students, players or siblings are allowed inside or outside the gym without adult supervision. The rule applies at all times during games, practices and tournament play.
 - a. The Athletic Program offers a variety of sports activities, which are organized through the Catholic Schools League. The students compete in swimming, soccer, table tennis, track, basketball, volleyball, softball and cross country.
 - b. Spirit Leader – Boys and girls in grades 6 through 8 will be allowed to participate in this extracurricular activity on a tryout basis. Participants must adhere to the attendance requirements for this activity as well as the academic/conduct requirements.
 - c. Players and spirit leaders must present themselves as good, respectful Christian citizens at all times. No makeup is to be worn at games or practices. Solid color shorts are required at all team practices. No Lycra or compression shorts are to be worn under an athletic short unless permitted by the Athletic Director.
5. Students –
 - a. Membership on a sports team or spirit leader squad requires acceptable behavior at all times – good sportsmanship, respect for coaches, players and officials during games and practices.
 - b. Participation in sports and spirit leading is a supplement the academic program.
 - c. Participation in the program requires attendance at all practices and games as required by athletic coaches or squad leaders.
6. Parents – While we welcome and encourage parent support and enthusiasm, we ask you to remain as spectators and enthusiasts during games. Any opinions and suggestions from you will be welcomed and considered by the coach and/or Athletic Director later. Concerns are not to be expressed to the coach on the playing field or in the gym while he/she is supervising the students.

SUSPENSION:

When a team or squad member fails to comply with the required school standards quoted above, there will be a minimum five (5) school days suspension beginning the day after the parent and Principal are notified verbally. All suspensions will be documented in writing to the student, parents and the Principal. **No suspensions take place without approval of the Principal.** If the Principal is unavailable, his designate will be notified verbally and in writing if necessary

ACADEMIC, EFFORT, CONDUCT, AND/OR HOMEWORK INELIGIBILITY:

Students who are academically ineligible may neither attend nor participate in practices. Students may attend games as spectators only. Students may not participate in games or spirit leading until academic, effort, conduct, and/or homework requirements are met.

VIOLATION OF TEAM/PRACTICE RULES OR GUIDELINES:

Students must attend practices all, but may not participate until appropriate requirements are met.
